Catalyzed shared learning to grow the vitality of our communities






16 Grants, \$80,000 to award

\$5,000 / 2 year term

Eligible Entities:

- 501(c)3's / Public Charities
- Governmental &
 Quasi-governmental Institutions,
 including tax exempt sovereign
 nations (Pueblos, Tribes, Nations)
 and municipalities and counties
- Educational Institutions, including higher education institutions, public school districts, public schools, local and state-controlled charter schools, and BIE- and tribally-controlled schools
- Ineligible Entities: Religious and social organizations








How we work our TOC.
