Goodbye to Jenny!

In the fall of 2023, Jenny Parks announced her decision to step down as President and CEO of LANL Foundation. Under her transformative leadership, Jenny made a lasting impact on our programs, including:

Early Childhood: Jenny was passionate about kinship families, having been raised in part by her grandparents. She recognized their value and challenges, making kinship families a key policy and advocacy priority.

K-12 Education: Jenny grew the program into a diverse department that aims to strengthen school leadership, teaching methods, and school ecosystems through collaborative programming.

Inquiry Science Education Consortium (ISEC): Under Jenny's guidance, ISEC grew into a program that focuses on not only inquiry science, but student social emotional health and culturally responsive teaching methods.

College, Career, and Community Pathways: It was Jenny's vision that brought the C₃P program to life. She believed in the importance of expanding opportunities for our youth.

Scholarships: Under Jenny's leadership, the program expanded from financial aid to comprehensive student support services. The LANL Scholar Ambassador program was launched, greatly enhancing support for our scholars.

Grants: Jenny created our Grants program and hired staff focused on equitable grant development and management. She transformed our grantmaking from transactional to relational, providing support beyond financial aid, which enhanced our grantees' capacity.

Research: Under Jenny's leadership, we became a learning organization. She prioritized research, amplifying the voices of northern New Mexico's students and educators. Our reports combine their perspectives with peer-reviewed research and policy trends, guiding our programs and advocacy.




2023: A Year of Gatherings


Groups Represented at LANL Foundation Gatherings

Early Childhood

The Early Childhood Program is committed to strengthening children, families, and communities in a culturally respectful way.

COLLABORATING WITH OUR TRIBAL COMMUNITIES:

Between the Tribal Advisory Committee and the Tribal Home Visiting Program, we strived to meet the traditional and cultural needs of the Pueblos and tribal lands with guidance from communities.

DEVELOPING STRENGTHENING PATHWAYS FOR NATIVE EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATORS:

We celebrated the second graduating cohort of the Tribal Early Childhood Educator Pathway Cohort. This partnership with Central New Mexico Community College, with support from the Brindle Foundation, covers the cost of tuition, fees, and books and provides mentorship for students pursuing their Child Development Certificate, earning 13 college credit hours.

EARLY CHILDHOOD COLLABORATIVES:

The Rio Arriba County Early Childhood Collaborative (RACECC) now operates in both northern and southern Rio Arriba County. These groups of stakeholders include educators, nonprofits, healthcare providers, and more working to make the best possible environment for healthy growth and child development.

FREE ONLINE TRAININGS:

Our free virtual trainings have taken off with more and more participants every time! Guest experts led seminars on topics including raising children with special needs and supporting grandparents and kin raising children.

Our partnership and collaboration between the Eight Northern Indian Pueblos' Council (ENIPC) and LANL Foundation's Early Childhood Program has been a uniquely rewarding experience. Together, we have established foundational relationships with Pueblos to strengthen early childhood education. As we continue to evolve and grow, our primary focus remains supporting the health, culture, and language of young children to achieve greater long-term outcomes in whole child development. ENIPC remains a committed partner of LANL Foundation, and we eagerly anticipate the future of this critical and ongoing work."

K-12

The K12 Program supports school and district leaders, provides teachers with professional development, and aims to recruit and retain educators across our region.

INQUIRY SCIENCE EDUCATION CONSORTIUM:

Our ISEC Team delivered over 350 science modules to more than 40 schools for both the fall and spring semester. We also continued our invaluable, high quality professional development trainings for teachers.

EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AWARD:

For the seventh year in a row, supported by Northern New Mexico Integrated Security, we honored eight teachers from Rio Arriba County and Pojoaque with the Excellence in Teaching Award. These inspiring educators were all surprised at their schools with checks for \$1,000 and much appreciation after being nominated by their students and colleagues.

NATIONAL BOARD CERTIFIED TEACHER PROGRAM:

We were recognized by the New Mexico National Board Certified Teacher Network for our work to support and develop teachers in our region. We were singled out for our efforts to recruit and bolster candidates seeking their certification.

C3P C3F

The College, Career, and Community Pathways (C3P) Program believes everyone has a unique contribution to make and deserves to be able to earn a living doing something meaningful in their community.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT IN TRIBAL NATIONS AND NATIVE COMMUNITIES:

We partnered with the New Mexico Native American Workforce Partners, a network of tribal workforce development programs, to help secure funding, increase their overall capacity, and improve community engagement.

CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION (CTE):

We supported Cuba Independent School District, Española Public Schools, Peñasco Independent School District, and Santa Fe Indian School to strengthen and expand their CTE efforts.

INNOVATION ZONES INITIATIVE:

We provided technical support to school districts to help high schools become designated New Mexico Innovation Zones. We helped the Public Education Department establish two statewide advisory groups to support the Innovation Zones Initiative and provided technical support to northern New Mexico school districts to help them secure New Mexico Innovation Zone funding and support.

WORK-BASED LEARNING:

We continued to support the LevelUp! Internship program, recruiting additional hotels to enable 69 youth participants to have internships in 2023. We also helped develop a similar program to the north, which enabled 37 additional internships.

SUPPORTING YOUNG PARENTS & CAREGIVERS:

We launched a new project to help young parents and caregivers access work-based learning and career training.

NORTHERN NEW MEXICO PATHWAYS TO OPPORTUNITY STRATEGY TABLE:

We led the Strategy Table in completing an unprecedented 82-page "Investing in College and Career Pathways for Youth in Northern New Mexico" fiscal mapping report the with the Children's Funding Project and engaged stakeholders to plan for increased investments.

ScholarshipsScholarships

The Scholarship Program supports students from northern New Mexico in their pursuit of undergraduate degrees and professional certifications by providing both financial awards and a robust community of support. Our scholars include students graduating high school as well as adult and non-traditional students.

SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED:

In partnership with the Los Alamos Employees' Scholarship Fund (LAESF), we awarded 110 amazing students scholarship awards totaling \$839,000 to support them in their pursuit of undergraduate degrees. 41 Career Pathways scholarships totaling \$111,250 were awarded to students and adult learners earning an associate's degree or professional certification. To date, LANL Foundation has awarded over \$11 million to more than 2,300 students from northern New Mexico.

FUNDRAISING:

700 LANL employees donated \$445,000 to the Los Alamos Employees' Scholarship Fund, the second largest amount raised in the fund's history. Triad National Security contributed an additional \$178,000 to provide scholarships to students with significant financial need.

The Grants Program invests in individual, organizational, and institutional capacity to facilitate collective learning and changemaking in the ecosystem of education in northern New Mexico.



AdvocacyAdvocacy

The 60-day 2023 legislative session was the first true test of our new advocacy framework. We advocated for over \$342 million in appropriations and capital outlay to improve access to early childhood programs, support high school career technical education (CTE) and paid internships, promote higher education completion, strengthen Native education, and recruit and retain teachers and other school professionals.

The General Appropriations Act of 2023 included these priorities that we advocated for:

- \$40 million for Innovation Zones, CTE, and work-based learning
- \$11 million for Home Visiting programs
- \$20 million for the Indian Education Fund
- \$1 million for Early Childhood Education Coalitions
- \$191 million for the New Mexico Opportunity Scholarship



ENACTED LEGISLATION!

WE WORKED WITH PARTNERS TO SUPPORT BILLS THAT:

- Enabled the NM Early Childhood Education and Care Department to enter agreements with Tribes that respect their use of culturally and linguistically relevant standards and assessments. (House Bill 148)
- Achieved salary equity for National Board Certified educators, extending pay increases to principals, counselors, and other school staff. (House Bill 181)
- Revised statutory language to allow the nine Bureau of Indian Education-funded schools in our state to access the same CTE funding as school districts and charter schools. (House Bill 198)
- Established two Technical Assistance Centers for Indian Education to better serve Native students. (House Bill 280)


